Devices imported or sold in Canada must meet eleven fundamental safety and effectiveness requirements. Devices in Class II are held to a higher level of assurance than Class I devices. Class II devices are certified that they will perform as indicated and will not cause injury or harm to patient or user. Devices in this class are typically non-invasive and include powered wheelchairs, surgical and acupuncture needles, orthopaedic implants, and haemodialysis and disk decompression machines. T-Zone Whole Body Vibration is certainly a proven and revolutionary therapy to complement and enhance exercise regimes and rehabilitation.
